Shareholders in the Putnam Floating Rate Income Fund on the record dates per the attached statement received distributions, a portion of which represent a return of capital. As a result of the non-taxable distributions, the shareholders of record will be required to reduce the basis in their RIC common shares of this fund by amounts designated as a return of capital.

15 Describe the quantitative effect of the organizational action on the basis of the security in the hands of a U.S. taxpayer as an adjustment per share or as a percentage of old basis ▶

The shareholders' basis in their shares of this RIC is reduced by the distributions paid during calendar year 2012 which have been determined to be a return of capital. The impact to the shareholders' basis, on a per-share basis, can be found on the attached.

The Putnam Floating Rate Income Fund had a return of capital of \$215,709 at its fiscal year ended 2/29/12. This represents 6.649611% of the 2012 distributions which were paid in this fiscal year of \$3,243,934. See attached for per share amounts.

The portion of the distributions which are taxable as a dividend is determined under IRC §316(a) - Definition of Dividend - distributions from current and accumulated earnings and profits of the taxable year. The distributions which are not taxable as a dividend are characterized as a return of capital and used to reduce the shareholders' basis in their shares of the fund as provided for under IRC §301(c)(2).
