Mr. Woodall is Chief of Operations for Putnam Investments. He is responsible for Mutual Fund Shareholder Services, Accounting, Middle Office and Control Services, and Investment Operations. Mr. Woodall joined Putnam in 1993 and has been in the investment industry since 1983.

Previously at Putnam, Mr. Woodall held several roles, including Head of Mutual Fund Shareholder Services, Vice President of Investor Services, Head of Business Planning and Development, and Head of Enterprise Services.

He is the former Chair of NICSA (National Investment Company Service Association) and a Director Emeritus.
