Mr. Schoen is Co-Chief Investment Officer, Global Asset Allocation (GAA), and a member of Putnam's Operating Committee. In his role as Co-CIO of GAA, he directs the overall strategy and positioning of Putnam's GAA products. Mr. Schoen oversees the research that drives equity security selection strategies, portfolio construction, and risk management for GAA portfolios. His work also contributes to Putnam's *Capital Markets Outlook*. In addition, Mr. Schoen is a Portfolio Manager of Putnam's target-date, traditional asset allocation, multi-asset income, and total return strategies. He is also a member of Putnam's ESG Leadership Committee. He joined Putnam in 1997 and has been in the investment industry since 1990.

Previously at Putnam, Mr. Schoen served as a Co-Head of GAA, Head of the Quantitative Models group, and an Analyst in the GAA group. Prior to joining Putnam, Mr. Schoen was an Independent Financial Consultant at Schoen Timing Strategies from 1992 to 1997 and Head of Research at Signalert Corporation from 1990 to 1992.
